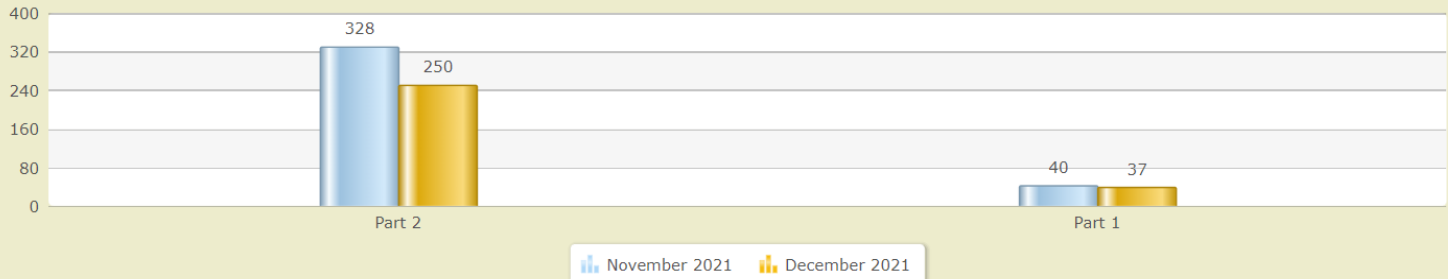

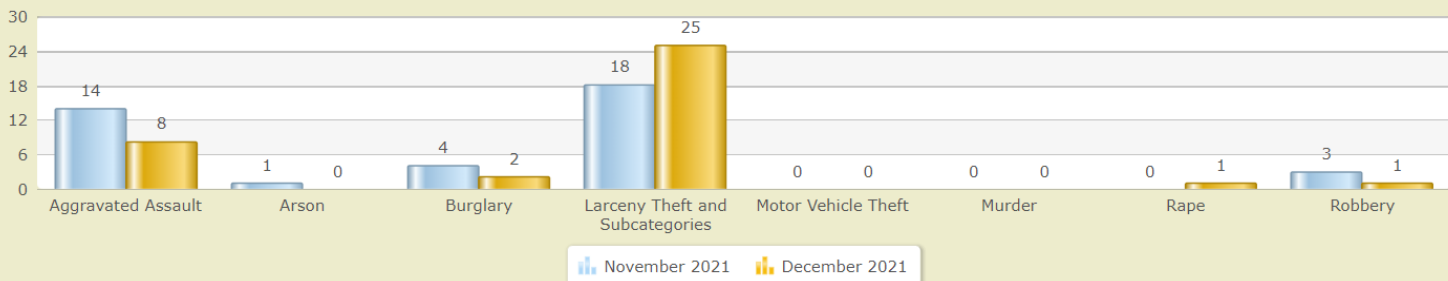
## November 2021 vs. December 2021 COMPSTAT Analysis

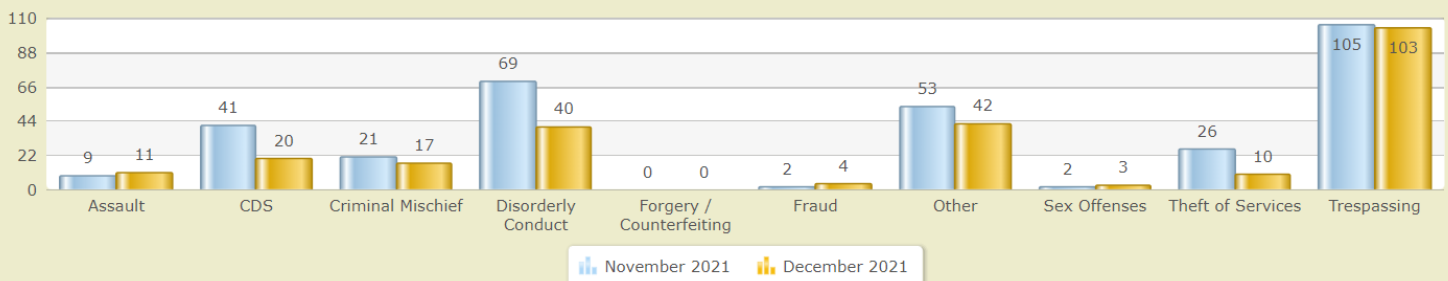

From November 2021 to December 2021, commandwide there was a 7.5% decrease in Part 1 crimes and a 24% decrease in Part 2 crimes. Most significantly, commandwide there was an 66% decrease in robberies, a 43% decrease in aggravated assaults, a 39% increase in thefts, a 50% decrease in CDS offenses, a 61% decrease in theft of service, and a 42% decrease in disorderly conduct. All other offense types had minimal or no change.

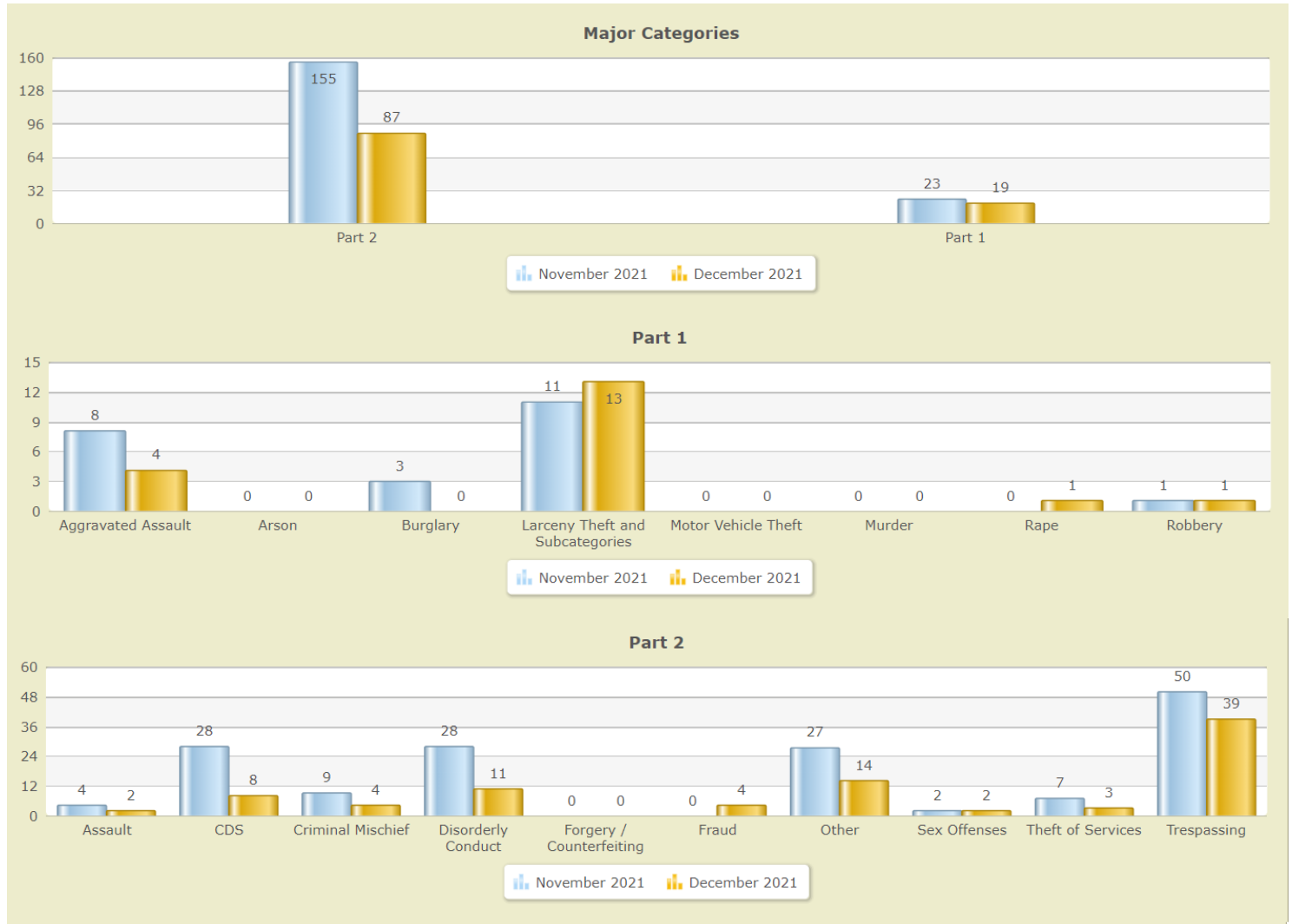

### DISTRICT 2



From November 2021 to December 2021, District 2 had a 17% decrease in Part 1 crimes and a 44% decrease in Part 2 crimes. Most significantly, District 2 had an 300% decrease in burglaries, a 100% increase in rape, a 50% decrease in aggravated assaults, a 71% decrease in CDS, a 61% decrease disorderly conduct, a 400% increase in fraud, and a 48% decrease in “other” offenses. All other offense types had minimal or no change.

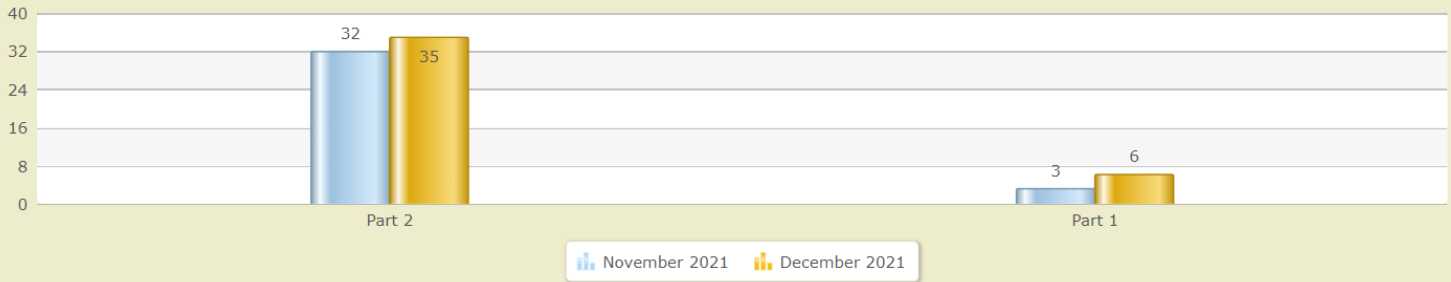

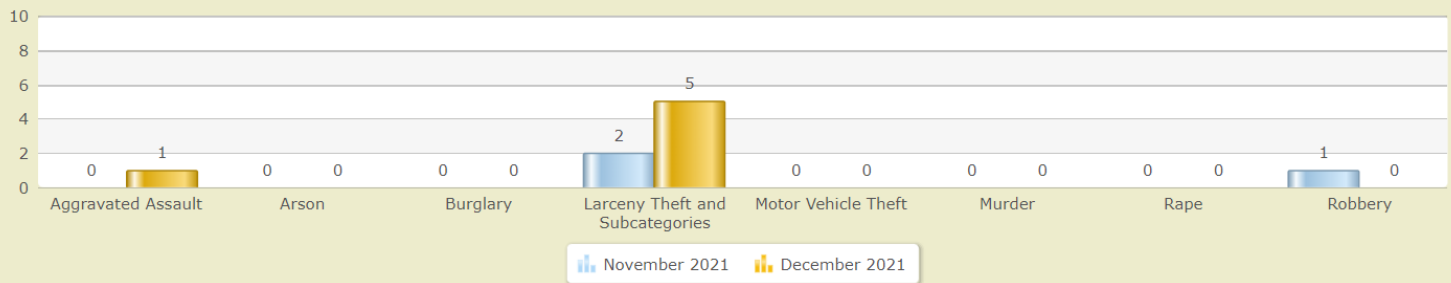

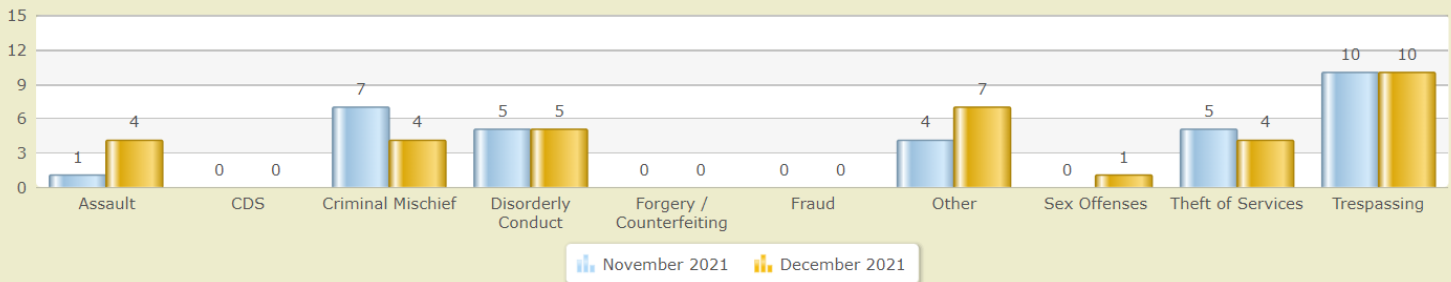

From November 2021 to December 2021, District 3 had a 100% increase in Part 1 crimes and a 9% increase in Part 2 crimes. Most significantly, District 3 had an 150% increase in thefts, a 100% decrease in robbery, a 300% increase in assaults, a 75% increase in “other” offenses, and a 43% decrease in criminal mischief. All other offense types had minimal or no change.

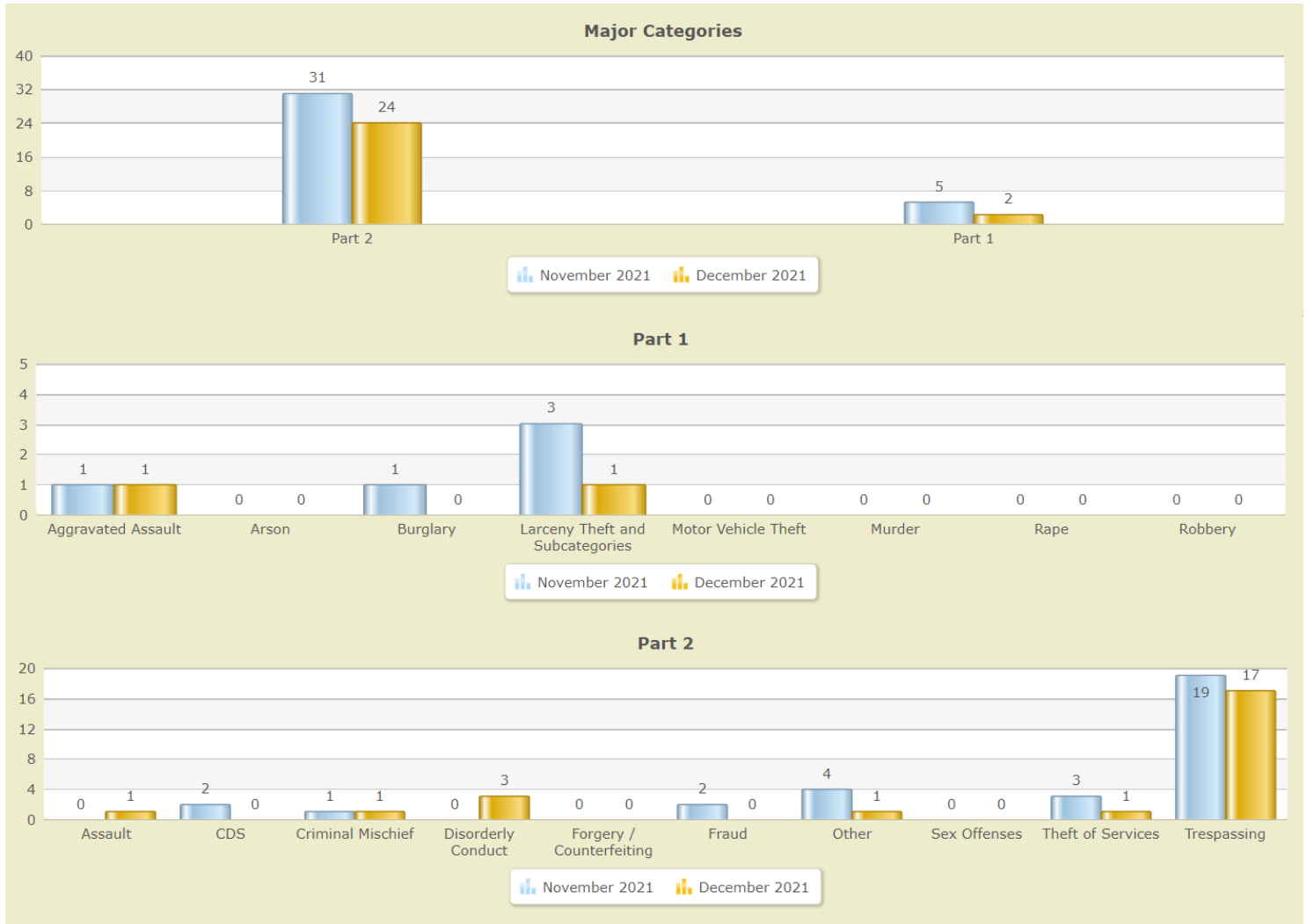

From November 2021 to December 2021, District 4 had a 60% decrease in Part 1 crime and a 23% decrease in Part 2 crime. Most significantly, District 4 had a 67% decrease in theft, a 100% decrease in burglary, a 200% decrease in fraud and CDS offenses, and a 75% decrease in “other” offenses.. All other offense types had minimal or no change.

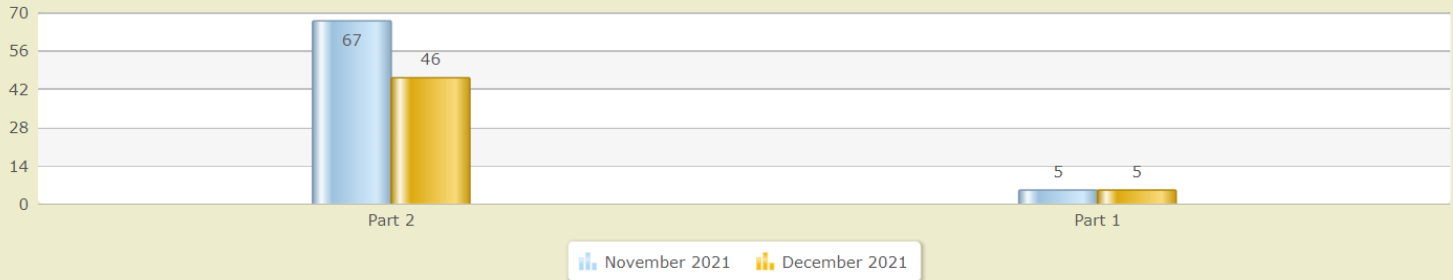

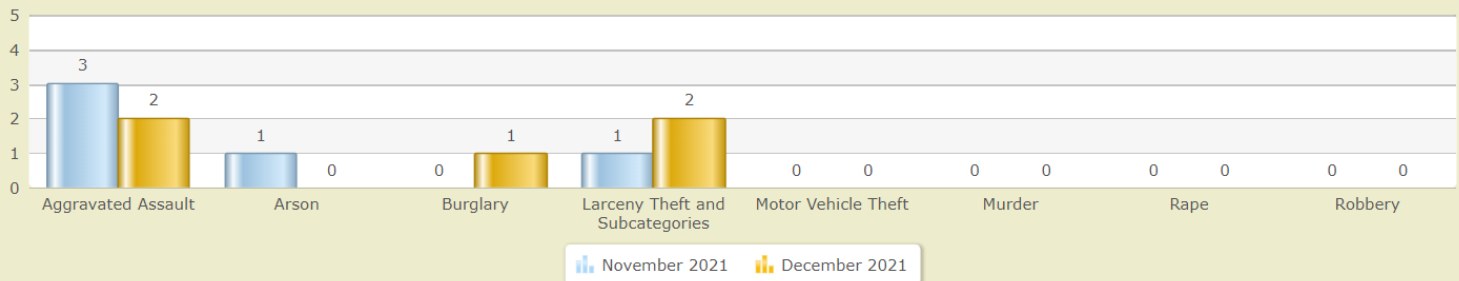

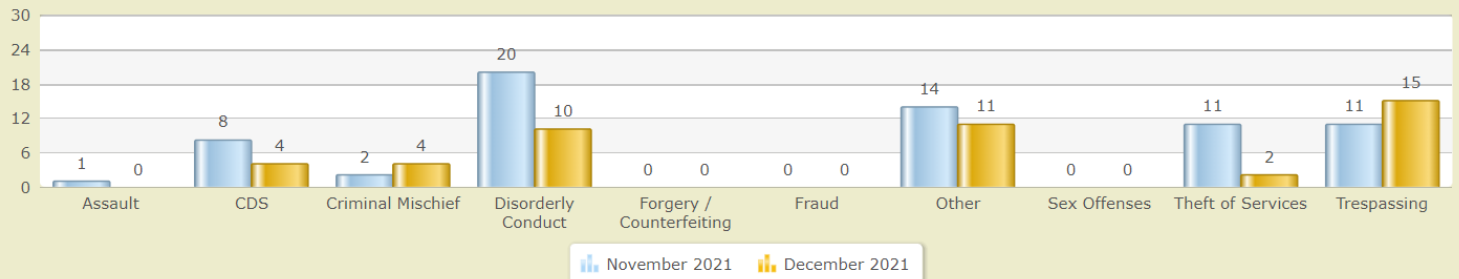

Most significantly, District 5 had a 50% decrease in disorderly conduct, a 50% decrease in CDS offenses, and an 82% decrease in theft of service. All other offense types had minimal or no change.

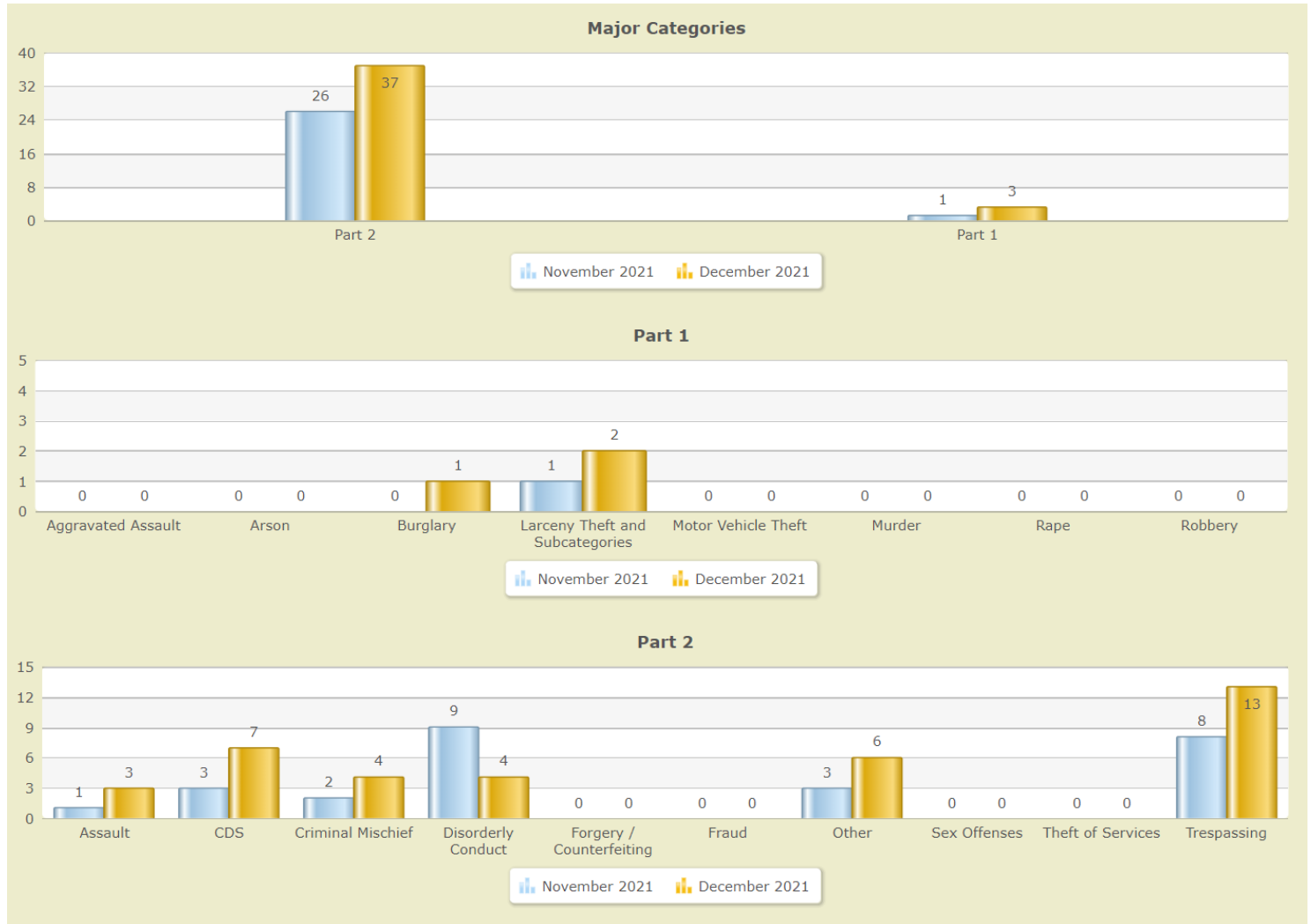

Most significantly, District 6 had a 133% increase in CDS offenses, a 100% increase in burglary, a 100% increase in theft and a 55% decrease in disorderly conduct. All other offense types had minimal or no change.

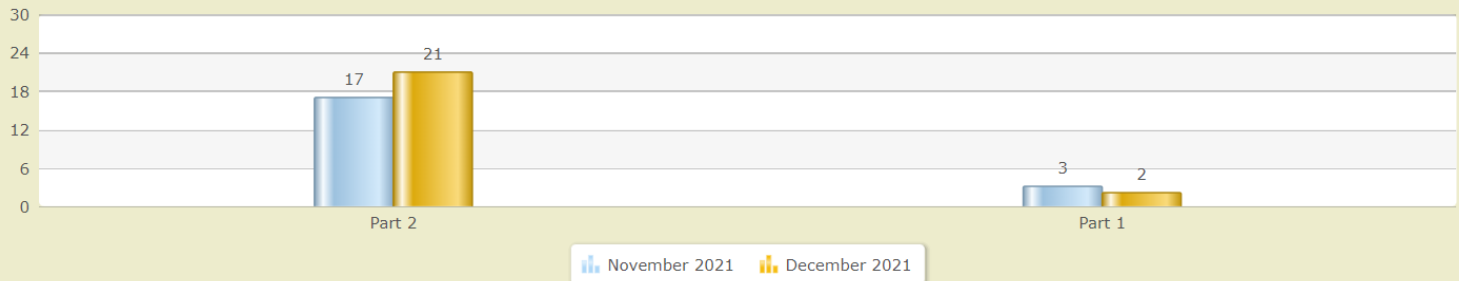

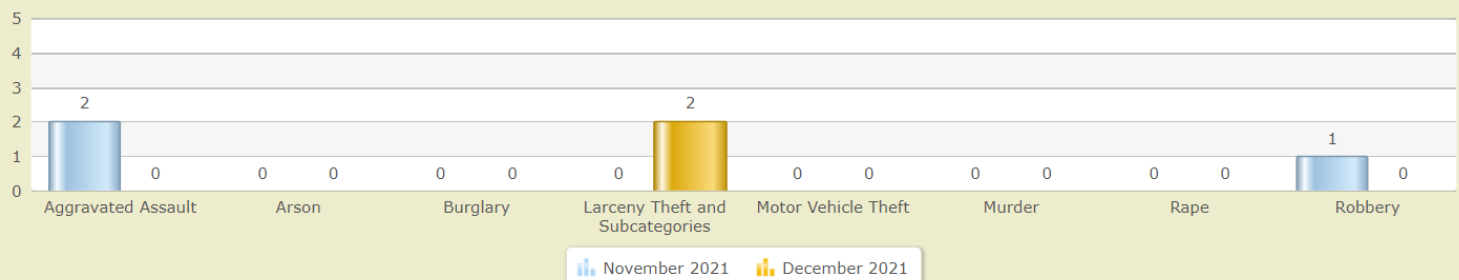

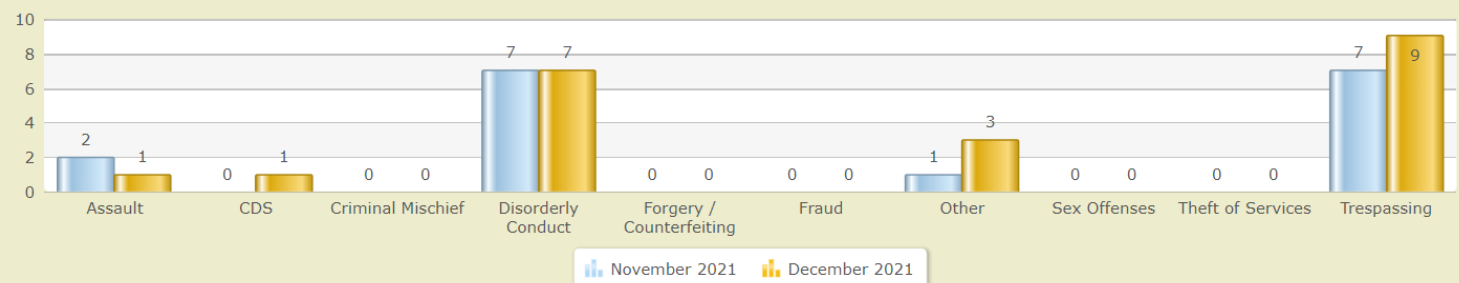
